Student Liaison (Eric)

- MLHS botanical Garden. The MLHS EC has thanked Bednar for providing plants & people using Instagram. Also, a plaque will be designed to thank all that contributed.
- MLHS EC is raising funds for ocean, river & beach cleanup, the removal of plastic waste. They raised about \$112 so far (after school bake sale & online: https://gofund.me/5a8bfaba).

Lake Management (Allison)

- The Wildwood Lake Living Shoreline Project is in the information gathering stage.
- SOLitude has presented their annual year-end report (https://mtnlakes.org/wp-content/uploads/2014/09/2020-Lakes-Year-end-Report.pdf):
 - It has been a year of extremes
 - The Hydro raking of other lakes then Birchwood was paused, a possible restart was discussed. The Borough Council will budget an initial study into the maintenance of the lakes.
- Sunset Dam. There will be looked into possible additional funding from the new infrastructure bill.

Green team (Mimi)

- Green Team plans to use Earth Day (April 22, 2022) to inform public and entrepreneurs about the upcoming single-use plastic bag ban (May 4, 2022).

5. Any Other Business

- Plastic Straws. There are still businesses in Mountain Lakes that are handing out plastic straws. This should only be done upon request of the costumer. One solution is to discuss this with business owners and provide them with helpful table brochures. Another solution is informing the Mountain Lakes inspector.
- Legacy Condos (corner Morris Avenue & Fanny Road). The Stormwater management report is missing. Who is responsible for this report?
- Mimi put together a packet for DPW with all the stormwater management plans that the EC agreed on.
