1. Public Comments

• Mr. Brian Marshall attended for the Cove Riparian Buffer discussion

2. Cove Riparian Buffer

- Mr. Marshall presented a history of this riparian buffer which was recognized by the NJ DEP. The area is in a situation that is difficult to maintain.
- The Environmental Commission recommended to Council to maintain all of the existing healthy native plants and add a combined grass and clover cover for residents to enjoy, or as an alternate repopulate with additional native plants.

3. ANJEC Roundtable

 Mimi Kaplan, Kyla Hunter, and Megan Beik represented Mountain Lakes at this May 16th meeting. Various presentations were made and networking with other local municipalities. A NJ Environmental Municipal Alliance is being formed.

4. ML Storm Water Pollution Prevention Team

5. Zeri's Inn 372 US-46, Mountain Lakes Development
