COUNTY OF MORRIS, NJ**

**HEALTH COMMISSION MINUTES
September 6, 2017**

1. CALL TO ORDER; OPENING STATEMENT

The meeting was called to order at 5:42p.m. by Dr. Stillman, and the Open Public Meetings Statement was read into the minutes.

2. ROLL CALL

Commission members Dr. Rick Stillman, Dr. Jesse Silverman and Marla Ravin (arrived at 5:46pm) were in attendance, as well as Health Officer Mike Fitzpatrick, and Board of Health Secretary Cara Fox. Commission Member Barbara Girz were absent, as well as Council Liason Bill Barrett.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

With consent of the Commission, Dr. Stillman opened the meeting for public comment. There were no members of the public present who wished to address the Commission.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Mr. Stillman, second by Dr. Silverman, to approve the Health Commission meeting minutes from May 23, 2017.

5. BOROUGH UPDATE

Ms. Fox advised the Borough is in the process of scheduling the annual Flu Clinic in October.

6. HEALTH OFFICER REPORT

Mr. Fitzpatrick reviewed his report. The pool at Sportscore Physical Therapy was closed as a result of testing positive for Pseudomonas. The pool reopen after 3 weeks after having 2 consecutive negative tests. A complaint about the conditions at Ruff Rehab was reported on 9/1/17 and is being investigated.

Mr. Fitzpatrick reported that electrocution in lakes is highly uncommon. Mr. Fitzpatrick reported the Borough Health Department in conjunction with Morris County Prevention is Key will be hosting an Opioid Overdose Training Seminar at the Lakeland Hills YMCA on November 16th at 6pm.

7. COMMISSION DISCUSSION

Dr. Stillman questioned if municipalities are required to post online the most recent health inspections of food establishments. Mr. Fitzpatrick advised municipalities aren't required to post them online and pointed out that food establishment inspection reports can be obtained via the Open Public Records Act. He advised that all food establishments receive either a Satisfactory, Conditional Satisfactory, or an Unsatisfactory placard that must be in public view.

8. ADJOURNMENT

Motion made by Dr. Stillman, second by Dr. Silverman, to adjourn the meeting at 6:15p.m. with all members in favor signifying by "Aye".
