Discussion regarding Operating models for Committee and Commissions

There was a discussion regarding committees and commissions and how the Open Public Meetings Act relates to each body. Ms. Horst read a prepared statement regarding this matter. It was her suggestion that all bodies be required to keep simple minutes and allow the meetings to be open to the public. Mr. Oostdyk explained the legal requirements for committee and commission meetings. The matter was further discussed by Council. It was decided that a chart with all of the Borough's committees/commissions be drafted that lists each body and what type of group they are; Commission, Advisory Committee or Council Sub Committee and their requirements as to minutes and allowing the public to attend.

Beach Renovation Project Update

Mr. Sheola presented an update of the plans for the beach projects. He pointed out the differences from former plans. (Eliminating a volleyball court and moving showers for Birchwood). DEP permits are required for this project. This process has been started. There was a question regarding the fall zone material for the swing set area. This will be looked into. The updated plans for Island Beach were reviewed. Mayor Holmberg asked about repairs for walls at both beaches. The walls will be addressed. A DEP permit is also required for the Island Beach renovations.

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COUNCIL REPORTS

Ms. Korman reported on the Environmental Commission. There will be a new member on the next Council agenda for appointment to the Commission. They are looking for a student member. Affordable Housing will be meeting in May. Ms. Horst stated that the Public Works committee met regarding the beach projects. Mr. Happer reported on the Historic Preservation Committee. The dynamite shed project is finished. Ms. Barnett commented on the Communications committee. They are looking into website analytics. They are looking into building a section on the website for borough construction projects. Mayor Holmberg suggested that this be on the front page. She commented on Shade Tree. They are reviewing the tree pruning list. They discussed the Emerald Ash Borer problem. Mayor Holmberg spoke about the Memorial Day celebration. He asked all of Council to march in the parade. He spoke about Mountain Lakes Day. He asked the council to suggest to their committees that they have a table at the event. Mayor Holmberg asked everyone to think about how the agenda process can be improved.

Mayor Holmberg opened the meeting to the public.

Mr. Fred Kanter, 81 Hanover Road, made comment regarding the parking ordinance. He stated that the reasoning behind passing the ordinance was not in the minutes. He commented on Cove Park and the lack of ADA compliance. He made comments regarding the meeting minutes and how they misrepresent what he says.

Ken Adams, 388 Morris Ave., thanked the council for the information regarding the Lake Drive project and the equipment staging problem. He stated that if the Borough does not do anything about the effected trees and they fall on his house, he will sue the town. He suggested that the town get money in escrow regarding this problem. He made comment regarding the Council going into Executive session. He asked what topic could be discussed that the public cannot hear. He commented on transparency and that the council needs to stay transparent.

Rich Grebe, 4 Roberts Drive, stated that during his term on the Finance Committee there were only two people from the public that attended meetings. He did not think there would too many residents who would like to attend committee meetings. He stated that if members of the public have questions they should contact the council or the council liaisons. He suggested that someone on the borough staff reach out to the committees to ask for their minutes so that they can be put up on the website.
