Hepatitis A

Present in the faeces of an infected person & is most often transmitted through contaminated water or food.

Symptoms

Fatigue Nausea Abdominal pain Loss of appetite

Hepatitis B

Transmitted through exposure to infected blood,, semen, and other body fluids.

Symptoms

Yellowing of the eyes Abdominal pain Dark urine

Hepatitis C

Transmitted through exposure to infected blood.

Symptoms

Joint pain Stomach pain Sore muscles

Hepatitis D

Infections only occur in those who are infected with Hep B.

Symptoms

Fatigue Nausea Stomach pain

Hepatitis E

Mostly transmitted through consumption of contaminated food.

Symptoms

Yellowing of the eyes Nausea Lack of appeite
