- 6. **Saplings to be planting on Intervale Road** JCP&L gave 20-25 saplings to Parsippany to be planted in the area off Route 46 where they took down many trees last year.
- 7. **Stump Removal & removing vines**: Cynthia talked to the Borough Manager about the issue of stump grinding and vine removal. The Manager said stump grinding is expensive and also the DPW is has a lot of other pressing concerns. The Manager said he could put vine removal as part of the RFP when the town goes out to bid for tree work.
