### Committee Chair Opening (Ethan Grodofsky)

### Old Business

- Grunden's Pond No update. Ferraro Engineering is still waiting for Geo Technical report. Still targeted to be addressed when the work on Sunset is being completed.
- Sunset They are working through the Easement Process, we believe we have 4 out of the 5 homeowners' approval, we are expecting issues with one. The process should take a few more months. A 2% State Loan from the Dam Fund will be used to drain the lake.

## Borough Managers Report (Mitch Stern)

- Cove & Wildwood Hydro-raking has been completed.
- DPW has been removing logs and debris at Birchwood Lake.
- USDA will do Swan Management in addition to the current Goose Management.
- The idea of Dredging was discussed. Mitch referenced a 2020 cost proposal for Sunset, 1.7 ft of Silt depth, 35,572 yards at \$100 per yard. Estimate cam in at about \$3.8 mil.
- Mitch was going to talk to the Mountain Lakes Club about sand in the Canal.

### Solitude Lake Management Report (Bob Schindler)

- Water temperatures are in the 40s, not a lot going on as to algae blooms and growth.
- Will be focusing on Milfoil on Wildwood and the Canal
- Water Primrose Treatment, primarily hand pulling, targeted for September. Area of focus, area between Island Beach and the Canal. Using hand tools is legal.
- Mountain Lake- Hydro-raking has not been done. There was an issue with he access to offloading on Residents' property.
- Wildwood Lake-May be able to further Hydro-rake the North end of the lake. It ma restore much of the water depth without dredging.
- Maybe the same on Sunset.

- For this we will use 'Permit by Rule' as long as we don't disturb the shoreline.
- Aerator systems on Shadow will be getting them up and running.
